<p>N/A</p>	<p>Check-Out Process Enhanced to Avoid Save/Conflict Documents</p> <p>The check-out process has been further enhanced to avoid multiple people checking out the same document at the same time. In the old process, two users could open the same document without checking it out immediately. Each would have a Check Out button. Once one of the users clicks the button, the other will now get the message “While you had this document open, it was checked out by <Other User’s Name>”.</p>	<p>System</p>
