<i>Changes to Scoping Document Traffic Control Form</i>	
384	<p><b>The radio buttons on the traffic control form of a scoping package will not be checked by default.</b></p> <p>Previous, when a scoping document was created, the traffic control form radio buttons would appear checked by default in read mode. This issue has been corrected so that none of the traffic control buttons are selected by default.</p>
<i>Changes to Package Document</i>	
404	<p><b>Users will no longer be alerted during validation that only a Form D4232 is required for CE Actions 21, 22, or 23.</b></p> <p>Only CE Actions 1, 5, 10, 13, 16, or 17 require a Form D4232 without documentation in the CEES. The CEES will no longer indicate that CE Actions 21, 22, or 23 also require only a Form 4232.</p>
<i>Changes to Form B: A-2</i>	
402	<p><b>Users are required to indicate that there is documentation when park and recreational property impacted by a project has been acquired through any of the listed recreational grants/funds in B: A-2.</b></p> <p>B: A-2 Parks &amp; Recreation Facilities: If any of the “Were any of the impacted properties acquired through the use of:” boxes are selected, the Documentation checkbox will be required. If the Documentation checkbox is not selected, an error will appear during form validation requesting that the error be corrected.</p>

403	<p><b>Users do not have to indicate whether mitigation has been incorporated into a project when there are no impacts to park and recreational facilities.</b></p> <p>B: A-2 Parks &amp; Recreation Facilities: When no impacts are selected for Parks &amp; Recreation Facilities, the “Is mitigation incorporated?” question is not required to be answered. No error will be generated.</p>
428	<p><b>The “Describe Mitigation” heading will no longer appear in read mode, if the “Is mitigation incorporated?” question is checked “No” in B: A-2.</b></p> <p>B: A-2 Parks and Recreation Facilities: The “Describe Mitigation” prompt will be displayed to users when “Is mitigation incorporated?” question is answered “Yes”. If the “Is mitigation incorporated?” question is answered “No”, the “Describe Mitigation” heading will be hidden in read mode.</p>
429	<p><b>Users are required to answer “Yes” to the question “Is mitigation incorporated?” when park and recreational property impacted by a project has been acquired through any of the listed recreational grants/funds in B: A-2.</b></p> <p>B: A-2 Parks &amp; Recreation Facilities: If any of the “Were any of the impacted properties acquired through the use of:” boxes are selected, the “Is mitigation incorporated?” question cannot be answered “No” or left blank. If the “Is mitigation incorporated?” question is answered “No” or left blank, an error will appear during form validation stating that the response cannot be “No” or blank.</p>
430	<p><b>Users are required to include an attachment if documentation is checked in B: A-2.</b></p> <p>B: A-2 Parks &amp; Recreation Facilities: If a park or recreational facility used funds from one or more grant programs listed under “Were any of the impacted properties acquired through the use of:”, then the appropriate corresponding documentation must be checked and attached. A warning message will appear stating that appropriate documentation must be checked and attached.</p>
