System-wide	<p><b>More enhancements for usability with recent web browsers</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For MS Internet Explorer (IE), users will now be emulating “Edge” or “10” modes.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ This allows the system to take better advantage of more modern approaches to internet styling and functionality.</li><li>○ The system can still only be used with the IE browser; other browsers may follow in future releases.</li><li>○ New Yes/No confirmations properly disable the rest of the system, awaiting user input.</li><li>○ Action buttons have been redesigned for better rendering and ease of system-wide style changes.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Buttons in action bar are now white; buttons in forms are now blue.</li></ul></li><li>○ The calendar date selector will now hover above/below its date field; whichever location keeps it from scrolling off the screen.</li></ul></li></ul>	9653 (partial)
Revision Requests	<p><b>Revision Request – Check Out Button</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An error has been fixed such that the Check Out button will no longer be erroneously visible on Revision Requests.</li></ul>	9584
Package Document – Emergency Projects	<p><b>Various changes to the Emergency Project section of the Package Document</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• When creating a CE Level 1a with Action Item #9, the Emergency Project and Declaration questions must both be Yes.</li><li>• The Repair Type question has been changed from radio buttons to checkboxes, allowing users to indicate both Emergency and Permanent at the same time.</li><li>• The “Add Appendix” link to the help file has been removed from the guidance note regarding Damage Inspection Reports.</li></ul>	9618, 9665, 19539
