123	<p>New button and view for document check in/outs</p> <p>A button titled "<u>Admin Check In</u>" has been added that allows District Administrators to override check outs on a document-by-document basis, checking the documents in regardless of who has them checked out.</p> <p><i>*Note: Administrators need to be careful with this button that they don't check in a document that might currently be in edit mode by the person who has it checked out.</i></p> <p>A new View "<u>By Check Out</u>" has been added to the navigator. This view shows documents organized by the name of the person who has them checked out. This will be a helpful tool for users to know what all they might want to check in before they leave the office for extended periods of time.</p>	Administration / System
128	<p>New reporting for Preservation PA</p> <p>The system will now generate a Comma Separated Values (CSV) file for Preservation PA every night. The data in this file will be picked up by their programmers, for presentation on their website (in conjunction with data in a CSV file to be created by MPMS on a weekly basis).</p> <p>Data is included in the CSV file only for packages with Section 106 Programmatic Agreement exemptions. Field values separated by commas include: MPMS, Pkg #, Phase, Classification, Level, Local Name, Exemption Codes, Exemption Date and Pkg Status.</p>	Reporting
140	<p>Package number has been added to the top of the BRPA matrix</p> <p>The package number now appears above the BRPA matrix so that it is printed with the document.</p>	BRPA

152	Reporting For ARRA No Longer Times Out The nightly report that posts data into DB2 for ARRA reporting was running beyond server limitations for length of time and memory. The process has been reconfigured to post SQL commands into an array, connect to DB2 and run all SQL commands at one time.	Reporting
