31	<p>Add Total Bridge Width (Existing and Proposed) to the Structure Document</p> <p>Total Bridge Width is measured from outside of barrier to outside of barrier, which should include sidewalks, when present.</p>	Forms*
32 & 43	<p>Fix MPMS Refresh on the Package Document</p> <p>When users deleted the topmost MPMS line, the refresh function was filling the first line with data that actually belonged on the second line and so on.</p> <p>When users refreshed data for an MPMS that never existed or no longer exists, header information was being switched to "TBD".</p>	System
36	<p>Remove "Executive Order 11990 Compliance" Checkbox from Wetlands Area on "Part B, Section A-1"</p> <p>This checkbox was redundant with other information collected in the Methodology portion of the Wetlands questions.</p>	Forms*

<p>37 & 48</p>	<p>Provide Impacts and Mitigation Questions Under Each Resource Section</p> <p>Augmenting each resource section with impacts and mitigation questions was coordinated with FHWA and a Task Force that was a subset of the CE User Group.</p> <p>When users refresh their forms, the “Part B, Section A-8” document (Temporary Impacts) is no longer needed and is therefore deleted by the system.</p> <p>With these form changes, the “Part B, Section E” document is automatically populated as a summary of mitigation data entered in the specific resource sections of the “Part B, Sections A-1 through A-5” and “Part B, Section B” documents. There are 15 additional fields for users to enter non-resource specific mitigation information. Data entered on the “Part B, Section E” document prior to the refresh will be deleted by the system when users refresh their forms.</p> <p>Because mitigation data entry is so different with this release, the mitigation report has been separated into two reports: “Pre-31.0” and “Post-31.0”.</p>	<p>Forms*</p>
